# Technology and the Future

All middle school students are provided opportunities to earn either a digital tool or industry certification through the completion of the following courses:

- iJourney: Students discover educational pathways offered in SCPS and develop a personalized career plan.
- e pathways
- iChallenge: This coding and game-based course prepares students to take AP Computer Science Principles in high school. (Semester or year-long options vary by school)
- iConnect: Students discover new possibilities and learn about technology applications and communication techniques.

### **Student Achievement**

- All students in 8th grade at Chiles Middle School have an opportunity to take the PSAT 8/9 at no cost. Lawton Chiles Middle
- Last year, Chiles 8th graders had an average score of 911 out of 1440, higher than the Florida average of 810.

- LCMS students earned a total of 1729 digital tool certifications in the 2020-2021 school year.
- Lawton Chiles athletes have won multiple district championships at the Junior Varsity and Varsity level.
- In 2019 students achieved a mean score of 911 on the PSAT, scoring above state average of 809.
